Game Instructions

Each player has a different counter and pencil and paper (or a small whiteboard and marker). Place a counter on any word and move in any direction. Roll a die to move.

When landing on a word, players must:

1. Look at the word
2. Say the word aloud
3. Cover the word
4. Write the word
5. Check the word is correct

Other players check as well to confirm the spelling is correct. If it is, the player gets a point. Keep the word in your list so you have a record of what you have landed on and spelled correctly.

*Players can **not** collect a point for the same word twice.

**Players aim to get 6 correct words. There can multiple winners. Each player who achieves the goal set might be rewarded with a sticker or stamp on the hand.



This game is a fun way to introduce young students to learning spelling lists with the process of look, say, cover, write check.
