Playing Instructions for Card Games
with Special Cards

1. Shuffle cards and place in a container so they cannot be seen (a plastic screw top jar or tin is great).
2. Take turns to pull out a card and read the card aloud.
3. If the card is a word card, the player keeps it if it is read correctly.
4. If the card is a special card, the player follows the instructions on it (miss a go, have another turn or take a card from another player).
5. Play until all cards have been taken. The player with the most cards at the end wins.
